I am very concerned about the effects of non-sustainable palm oil production on rainforests in Indonesia and Malaysia. At the rate that the rainforest is being cut down and burned, orangutans and other species are in real danger of extinction within the coming decade.

As a consumer of your products, I'm urging you to please consider making the following changes:

- Please join the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) to help move the entire palm oil industry to adopt ecologically sound practices (www.rspo.org). If you have already joined the RSPO thank you for taking a step in the right direction.
- When certified sustainable palm oil becomes available, only partner with those in the supply chain that meet the requirements for **RSPO certified** sustainable palm oil.
- After you have switched to certified sustainable palm oil, please label your products accordingly, including information on how much (what %) of the palm oil in each product is certified sustainable.
- Certified sustainable palm oil is starting to become available in the U.S. It will cost a little more. Unilever and many other companies have made a commitment to use certified sustainable palm oil only by 2015. I encourage you to make a similar publicly announced commitment to switch to 100% certified sustainable palm oil and a goal date for doing so. Consumers should be made aware of your commitment to the environment.

I would like to remain one of your customers, however am willing to support only those companies that adopt CERTIFIED sustainable practices when it comes to palm oil.
