General Description

Northeast Ohio's most popular year-round attraction, Cleveland Metroparks Zoo is home to 3,000 exotic animals representing 600 species. Welcome back elephants at the new African Elephant Crossing, explore the jungles of The RainForest, roam the Outback of Australian Adventure, take in the grassy plains of African Savanna, journey through Northern Trek, discover the exotic at the Primate, Cat & Aquatics Building and stroll along scenic Waterfowl Lake.

Discounted winter rates of \$8 for adults and \$5 for children 2-11 are offered November 1 to April 1. Regular admission as of April 2, 2011 will be \$11 for adults and \$8 for children ages 2-11. Located at 3900 Wildlife Way, the Zoo is easily accessible from Interstates 71, 77, 90 and 480. Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. with hours extended to 7 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The Zoo is open year-round except for December 25 and January 1.
