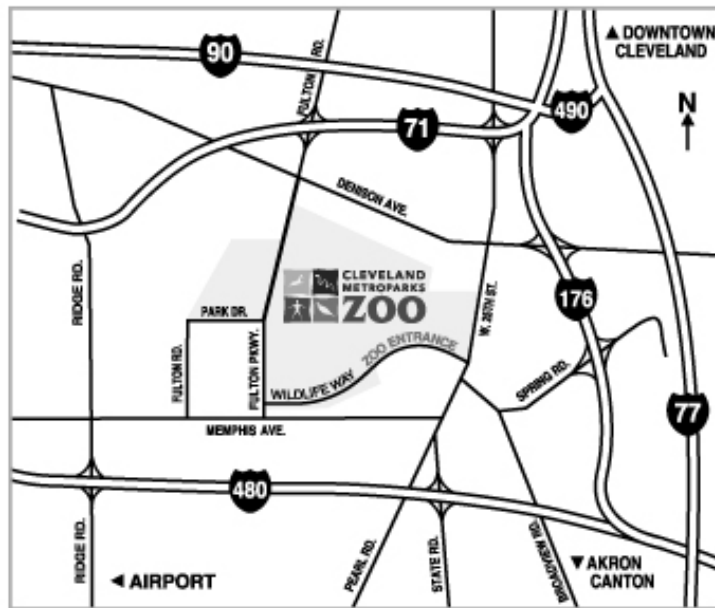

Directions

Cleveland Metroparks Zoo is located just 5 minutes from downtown and is easily accessible from Interstates 71, 77, 90 and 480. **Visitors should allow extra time to get to the Zoo** as roads around the Zoo may be particularly busy on weekends and holidays during the summer.



To avoid delays, the following routes to the Zoo are suggested:

From I-71: Exit at West 25th Street or Fulton Road and follow Zoo signs.

From I-90: Take to I-71 South, exit at West 25th Street or Fulton Road and follow Zoo signs.

From I-480: Exit Ridge Road north to Memphis Avenue and follow Zoo signs.

From Akron: Take I-77 North to I-480 West. Exit Ridge Road north to Memphis Avenue and follow Zoo signs.
